IMMIGRANTS' STEEP CLIMB TO SUCCESS

"Nearly half of immigrants to Canada between 2001 and 2006 are overqualified for the jobs they occupy. A much simpler and efficient credential-recognition process is needed. Language skills have proven critical to success. Those in the Federal Skilled Workers (FSW) programme proficient in either national language are 50% more likely to find a job and earn close to 40% more than FSWs who are minimally proficient in either language."
