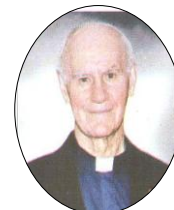

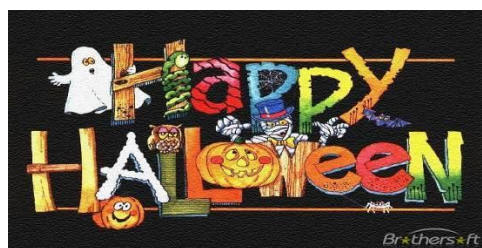

INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ERADICATION OF POVERTY

International Day for the Eradication of Poverty can be traced back to Oct. 17, 1987 when over a hundred thousand people gathered at the Trocadéro, Paris. The Universal Declaration of Human Rights was signed in 1948 to honor the victims of extreme poverty, violence and hunger. They proclaimed that poverty is a violation of human rights and affirmed the need to come together to ensure that these rights are respected.

Calls for vigorous and sustained action by the federal government to combat the structural cause of poverty in Canada.
