“Good Friday Justice Walk takes Faith to the Streets”



This March 29th the annual event begins at 2 p.m. at the Church of the Holy Trinity, beside the Eaton Centre. Gang violence, Idle No More, and the Sanctuary Movement to Protect Vulnerable Refugee Claimants will be the focus of the ‘stations’ for the Ecumenical Good Friday Walk for Justice.

The Ecumenical Walk in the downtown core – preceded and followed by worship in the church – links the injustice and suffering endured by Jesus of Nazareth 2000 years ago with injustices that afflict large segments of the population today. At about 4:30 pm a simple vegan meal follows the closing worship .

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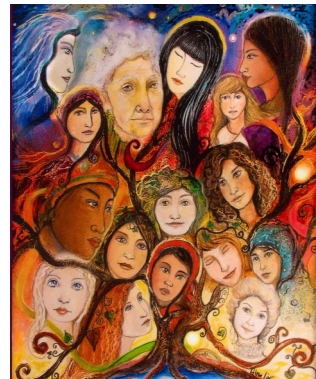
