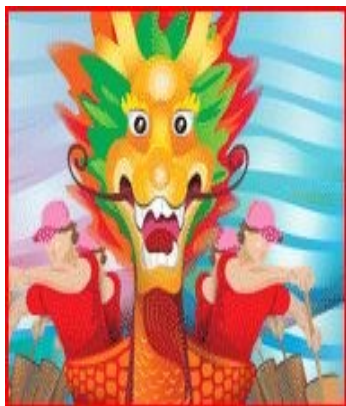

## Universal Declaration of Human Rights



In December 1948, with the end of the Second World War and with the creation of the United Nations, world leaders decided on this Declaration as a road map to guarantee the rights of all persons.

There are 30 Articles and each one represents the recognition of basic rights and freedoms for all human beings. Each person is born free and equal in dignity and rights, regardless of nationality, place of residence, gender, ethnic origin, colour, religion, language, or any other status.

### Place of Human Rights in Canada

We live in a country with strong human rights and we need to know how to apply these rights in every moment and circumstance of our daily lives.

In Canada, we have different Codes where we all have rights and responsibilities to make sure that everyone is treated equally and without discrimination.

## Canadian Citizenship Application

To be granted Canadian citizenship, you need to fill out an application form provided you fulfill the following requirements:

- Are a permanent resident
- Have completed 1,095 days living in Canada
- Have a clean criminal history
- Have knowledge of Canada, pass a test in English language skills and know the principal history, economic, and social realities of Canada
