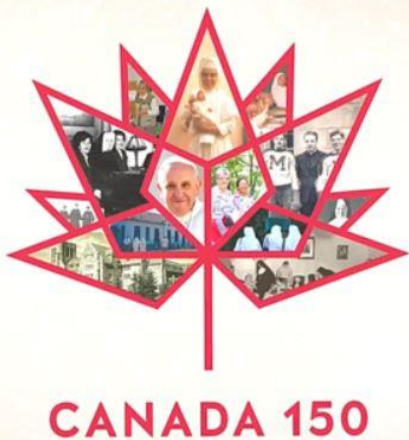


Summer Blessings to all of our dear Becoming Neighbours friends!!!
