



Living the Easter Triduum



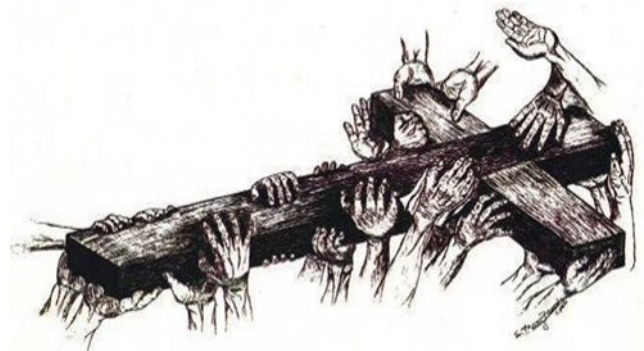
